

Nomination Guidelines 2020

Due to the current gathering restrictions, the Nominations Committee has laid out the following suggestions and guidelines that will be followed to hold a successful annual meeting and election.

Annual meeting to be held as a hybrid in person/virtual event. Each individual may login to the event either from their home or pre-register to meet at a predetermined location limited to 10 people.

Nomination & Election Guidelines

- 1) Due to Youth Board member terms limited to 1 year and the onset of CoVid19 early in 2020, this committee recommends current Youth Board members be allowed to run again this nomination cycle for 1 additional year.
- 2) Nomination forms are a "Self-nominating" format.
- 3) Other members may suggest an individual to be nominated. The suggestion may be made to the nomination committee. The nomination committee will contact the suggested individual.
- 4) Nominations will be taken from the floor.
- 5) All nominees must personally accept the nomination prior to being placed on ballot.
- 6) Nominees must be current 4-H members.
- 7) Voting will be a 2 step count. First at the club level and then at the organization level.
- 8) Every eligible current 4-H member, in attendance at annual meeting, will receive 1 ballot/vote towards the vote of the club.
- 9) Each club will receive 1 vote

Example: Candidates are Abby, Ben and Cole

There are 10 members of the Clover 4-H Club in attendance.

Each member voted and the results are Abby 3, Ben 3 and Cole 4.

Cole will win the vote for the Clover 4-H Club.

- 10) Countywide Leaders represent 1 club.
- 11) Chartered Committees are not clubs and do not receive a vote. (i.e. Market Animal, Shooting Sports)
- 12) Ballot counting will be performed by 2 members of the nomination committee and the 4-H Program Coordinator immediately after collection of ballots. Their decision is final concerning any questionable ballot.
- 13) Every effort will be made to disclose results within a reasonable time, the same day as election.
